

Gospel of Mark

THEME:

Jesus(82x) came so that the **crowds**(38x) would **see**(99x) His **immediate**(42x) **power**(49x), **hear**(52x) His authoritative **teaching**(35x) and **preaching**(15x) of the **gospel**(8x)of **God**(48x), bringing the **kingdom**(32x) of **God**(48x) to **mankind**(56x) showing that He is the **Son**(34x) of **Man**(56x), the **Christ**(7x). The Pharisees, **scribes**(37x), and **priests**(59x) refuse to **believe**(26x) and **wanting**(26x) the **authority**(10x) for themselves they **delivered**(68x) Him to die. But, those **willing**(26x) to deny self, become **disciples**(47x), and **follow**(21x) will be **saved**(16x).
